It has been a long time, but we are excited to be back and looking forward to welcoming you to our BB session for 2021-2022. We will endeavour to make BB as much fun as possible, whilst being mindful of keeping safe and adhering to current regulations and BB guidelines. Company & Junior Sections will resume on Tuesday, 12th October, with Anchor Boy Section commencing on Thursday, 21st October.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions we would ask that all parents wear a mask and maintain social distancing when dropping off and collecting boys at the outside door of the hall.

We will collect your contact information via registration form, as is normal practice. However, to fulfil our responsibility to comply with Government requirements for 'Track and Trace' we would advise you that it may be necessary to share your contact information with NHS Track and Trace if requested.

As a Company we have decided that uniform will not be mandatory this year instead if Anchor Boys and Juniors would wear tracksuit bottoms, trainers, and BB Jumper (if possible). Company section boys as above with a hoody or sweat top, along with a face mask which must be worn when moving around during the session. We would kindly ask that items of school uniform not be worn to BB for obvious reasons. Junior and Company section boys should also bring a labelled water bottle.

If your son or family member is displaying any signs of Covid-19, please do not send your son to BB. To keep our Boys Brigade safe, we would ask you to inform the Leader in charge as soon as possible if your child or a member of the household receives a positive PCR test for Coronavirus or develops the following Covid-19 symptoms: a high temperature; a new, continuous cough; a loss or change to smell or taste, tummy upset (in younger children).

If your son becomes unwell, showing signs of Covid-19 during a session, they will be taken with a leader to a well-ventilated area away from the rest of the group until a parent/guardian returns to collect them as soon as possible. At any time, leaders may have to self-isolate, and BB may have to be cancelled on an evening. We will endeavour to always communicate any such changes as soon as possible but please be prepared for BB to be cancelled at short notice before a session is due to commence or for a session to have to end prematurely.

A Registration evening will take place on: Thursday, 7th October 2021 from 6.30pm-7.30pm. Further details specific to the various sections will be available on this evening. We will also be happy to answer any questions you may have.

Registration fees this year will be £25 per boy to cover Capitation Fees from The Boys Brigade. Please ensure you include your Child's name as reference when making payment. Cash can be given on the night of registration; however, no change will be available.
